Thank you for your April 13, 2020 letter requesting postponement of your Year-Seven Evaluation of Institutional Effectiveness due to extenuating circumstances. Please accept this letter as approval of your request and official notification from the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) that Walla Walla University's date for the Fall 2020 Evaluation of Institutional Effectiveness self-evaluation report and visit is rescheduled to Fall 2021.
